

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

FEBRUARY 16, 2021

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Lovatt Room of the Sublette County Library on this date with Joel Bousman, Tom Noble, Doug Vickrey, Sam White, Dave Stephens, Matt Gaffney, Clayton Melinkovich, Brady Oltmans representing the Pinedale Roundup, and Carrie Long, County Clerk, present.

Chairman Bousman led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no additions to the Agenda as presented.

The minutes from the preceding meeting on February 2 were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner White. Motion carried.

Billy Pape, Road & Bridge Superintendent, met with the Board to update on activities.

It was moved by Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner White to move into Executive Session pursuant to W.S. 16-4-405(a)(vii), Real Estate.

The Board reconvened in regular session with no action taken.

Matt Gaffney, County Administrator, along with Janna Lee, Public Health, discussed the proposed relocation of Public Health offices within the proposed Critical Access Hospital. Chairman directed Gaffney to compose a working group with Commissioner Noble appointed to represent the Board to address the relocation of Public Health.

Jim Mitchell, Emergency Management, met with the Board to discuss the relocation of Emergency Management to the county owned Sand Draw facility. He proposed selling an ambulance referred to as Big Red to partially fund the move. The Board was not in favor of relocating Emergency Management but did instruct Gaffney to arrange for the sale of Big Red.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Vickrey to approve an MOU with Wyoming Department of Health to cover the cost of COVID vaccine in the amount of \$102,617.00. Motion carried.

Sue Briggs-Stanfill, representing the New Fork Irrigation District, updated the Board on recent communication with the Forrest Service.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner White to approve accounts payable. Motion carried.
