

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONS PROCEEDINGS AUGUST 20, 2019

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse on this date at 9:00 A.M. with David Burnett, Joel Bousman, Mack Rawhouser, Tom Noble, Doug Vickrey, Robert Galbreath representing the Pinedale Roundup, Matt Gaffney and Carrie Long, County Clerk present.

Chairman Burnett led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Burnett requested to amend the agenda by adding Town of Pinedale Mayor, Matt Murdock at 9:00 and Fire Warden, Shad Cooper at 11:00. Commissioner Noble made a motion to accept the amended agenda. Commissioner Vickrey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The minutes of the regular meeting on August 6, 2019, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Bousman, seconded by Commissioner Noble. Motion carried.

Matt Murdock, Mayor – Town of Pinedale, along with Wendy Boman and Dave Doorn representing the Sublette County Rural Health Care District, updated the Board on recent discussion regarding the ball fields located in Pinedale. Murdock reviewed several options the Town is considering with respect to the ball fields and the need the Rural Health Care has for them. He also stated the School District is interested in participating in the relocation of the ball fields and their upgrade depending on Sublette County's commitment to the project.

Chairman Burnett explained he believes the Board is willing to participate financially in the purchase of the land due to the collaborative efforts of all involved.

Billy Pape, Road & Bridge Superintendent, along with Eric Sackett and Mike Jackson representing Rio Verde Engineering, met with the Board to update on projects. Meadowlark is paved on schedule. Jackson stated the Cottonwood Ryegrass project should be ready for phase one next spring. He asked direction from the Board regarding the purchase of the culverts to turn over to the contractor for installation. Chairman Burnett instructed them to proceed with the purchase of the necessary culverts.

Chairman Burnett asked Pape about the progress with the Schedule A project. Pape asked for direction on putting out for bids. Should he request bids based on the project as he had submitted to the forest service or based on the amount of money available to see if more could be done than what he first submitted. Commissioner Noble suggested he include some baselines of what needs to be completed. Chairman Burnett instructed Pape to proceed with bids based on the amount of money available.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the purchase of the Communication Tower Shelters: Kismet Shelter in the amount of \$197,936.00 and Luman Shelter in the amount of \$184,911.00. Motion carried.

Joan Mitchell, representing the Big Piney Senior Center, and Andre Irey, Maintenance Superintendent, met with the Board to discuss the outdated sound system at the Senior Center. Irey explained to the Board the upgrade would cost approximately \$77,000. Chairman Burnett instructed Irey to proceed with the request for bids.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman, seconded by Commissioner Rawhouser to recess the meeting for an Executive Session in accordance with W.S. 16-405(a)(ii) personnel.

The Board resumed regular session. It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Noble to adopt the list of Exempt Employees as follows:

Jeness Saxton, Assessor, presented an abatement from Conoco Phillips in the amount of -\$1,771.90.

Chairman Burnett read a letter from the Mayor and Council from the Town of Marbleton expressing their support of improved and more efficient health care in Sublette County.

Shad Cooper, Fire Warden, met with the Board to update on department activities. He requested approval of the power line sharing agreement with Union at the Jonah tower site. Commissioner Bousman made a motion to approve the agreement, Commissioner Rawhouser seconded. Motion carried.

Cooper updated the Board on the recent Boulder Lake fire and commended the efforts of the volunteer fire staff on their quick response and persistent efforts. It was moved by Commissioner Bousman, seconded by Commissioner Noble to grant Cooper the authority to move forward with the Cost Sharing Agreement presently and in the event of future fires. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Dennis Fornstrom met with the Board to get current signatures for the Barger 4th Subdivision approved in the summer of 2018 but not signed by the prior Board or Clerk.

Commissioner Rawhouser updated the Board on the migration corridor meetings.

Commissioner Bousman made a motion requesting the Board support the Wyoming County Commissioners Association letter requesting funding to the Governor. Commissioner Rawhouser seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Vickrey attended the migration corridor meeting.

Chairman Burnett stated he attended the migration corridor meeting. He also attended the Pinedale Town Council meeting.

County Clerk, Carrie Long, stated the Wyoming Business Council had sent the money for the purchase of 64 Runway Lane, in accordance with the Enviremedial Grant.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 A.M.
