

**OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS  
APRIL 26, 2010**

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session, in accordance with W.S. 16-4-404(d), on this date at 6 p.m., in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse, to reconsider any actions taken at an Emergency Meeting held on April 25, 2010, at 8 a.m. with John Linn, Joel Bousman and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present. Chairman Bill Cramer was absent.

It was noted that public notice had been made at approximately 3:30 p.m. on this date.

Vice Chairman John Linn assumed the chair and conducted the meeting.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Acting Chairman Linn to recess the meeting for an Executive Session with Deputy County Attorney to discuss a personnel matter. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Acting Chairman Linn to reconvene the meeting.

Acting Chairman John Linn made the following statement:

On April 25, 2010, we held an emergency open meeting in accordance with W.S. 16-4-404(d). At the meeting, a motion was made and seconded to meet in an executive session regarding a personnel issue which is confidential and not open to the public, in accordance with 16-4-405(a)(ii). At that meeting, we determined that it was appropriate to officially request that the County Attorney investigate this matter.

All actions taken at an emergency meeting are temporary in nature. In order for actions taken at an emergency meeting to become permanent, they must be reconsidered with action taken at an open public meeting within 48 hours.

Today, we met to reconsider our decision. After discussing the matter and meeting with our attorney, we learned that the County Attorney could not investigate the matter due to a conflict of interest. The County Attorney has contact an outside agency to conduct the investigation. At the conclusion of the investigation, the results will be turned over to a special prosecutor to determine if any action should be taken. No further official action by this Board is warranted. Thank you.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
