

**OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS**  
**JUNE 25, 2010**

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session on this date at 1 p.m. with Bill Cramer, John Linn, Joel Bousman, Mari Muzzi of the Sublette Examiner, Megan Rawlins of the Pinedale Roundup, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

Chairman Cramer led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

In accordance with the public notice published in the Pinedale Roundup, on May 28, June 4, 11, and 18, 2010, public hearing was held for the renewal of the restaurant liquor license for Half Moon Lake Lodge, LLC. There being no objections, it was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the renewal. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the renewal application for a restaurant liquor license by Ft. William Recreation Area. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the renewal application for a restaurant liquor license by Boulder Lake Lodge, Inc., subject to the submission of an original notary page for Mr. Matt Patton; a copy of the lease, and a current Food Service License, by July 10, 2010, with no alcohol sales to occur until the license is issued. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to approve the renewal application for a retail liquor license by Wind River Resorts, Inc. dba White Pine Ski Area & Resort, without the requested second dispensing room. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to recess the meeting for an Executive Session with Deputy County Attorney Meredith Peterson to discuss a personnel matter. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to reconvene the meeting.

Butch Penton, Road and Bridge Superintendent, and Mark Eatinger, representing Rio Verde Engineering, discussed the location of a hot plant on County property for the Paradise County Road project. Two locations were discussed, with the Board advising Penton and Eatinger to use their best judgment on location and materials. The hot plant would be in use for approximately two weeks.

Ken Konicek informed the Board that office space will be available in the Elementary School this fall.

The Board discussed, with representatives of the Forest Service, BLM, Pinedale Volunteer Fire Department, County Fire Warden TJ Hunt, Pinedale Mayor Steve Smith and Councilman Dave Hohl, agency property needs and co-location possibilities. A committee, with the Town of Pinedale leadership, formed with members TJ Hunt, Alvin Mitchell, Dave Hohl, and representatives from the Forest Service, BLM, and Forest Service Fire Crew.

Chairman Cramer announced that Emergency Management Coordinator Bob Hanson is on administration leave with pay, pending a hearing. It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to appoint Jason Ray as the Interim Emergency Management Coordinator. The motion carried.

Dick Kalber, representing the Big Piney Marbleton Airport Board, discussed the recent bid opening for the apron expansion. The Board advised Kalber that the Airport Board needs to decide on Alternate #4. Old hangars on the property were discussed, and the Board advised that it was not willing to pay for the buildings or their removal.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
