

**OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS**  
**NOVEMBER 16, 2010**

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse in Pinedale, Wyoming, on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Bill Cramer, John Linn, Joel Bousman, Megan Rawlins of the Pinedale Roundup, and Mari Muzzi of the Sublette Examiner, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

Chairman Cramer led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The official bond for Marilyn Jensen, Treasurer for the Boulder Mosquito Abatement District, in the amount of \$1,000; was approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

Butch Penton, Road & Bridge Superintendent, discussed plowing Skyline Drive. A Memorandum of Agreement with the Forest Service and the Citizens to Save White Pine will be required. Penton discussed underground power at the Jack Creek Bridge project

Mark Eatinger, representing Rio Verde Engineering, reported that the Paradise project is closed down, due to the weather and Penton reported that dust suppression will be done when the road is in shape. Eatinger reported that the Buck Road project was closed down for the winter.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to adopt Resolution No. 10-100141C to change the name of New Fork Bridge County Road No. 23-175 to Peter S. Olson County Road No. 23-175. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to adopt Resolution No. 10-100140C to change the name of Pinedale Airport County Road No. 23-226 to Runway Lane County Road No. 23-226. The motion carried.

Deputy County Surveyor Skylar Wilson discussed the snow catcher easements and the gap in survey between Barger 3<sup>rd</sup> Subdivision and Big County Ranches Subdivisions.

Brad Clingman, Waste Management Superintendent, reported that the bagging system will be installed the week of November 29<sup>th</sup>. He reported on the quarterly Teton County meeting, recycling, and a meeting with Frank Grimes, representing Nelson Engineering, concerning the DEQ permit renewal application.

TJ Hunt, County Fire Warden, and Chris Fallbeck, Assistant State District Forester, presented three bids for the Flying A Fuels Reduction project. After discussion of the bids and options, it was moved by Commission Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to award the bid to Goss Company, LLC, in the amount of \$197,500, for aerial and ground removal. The motion carried, with the vote being: Cramer-nay, Linn-aye, and Bousman-aye.

LaVonne Stevens and Mel Kinikin, representing the Southwest Sublette Pioneers, discussed long-term senior services and housing in the County.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to recess the meeting for an Executive Session with Kathy Anderson, Treatment Court Coordinator, to discuss personnel. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to reconvene the meeting.

It was move by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to approve and sign the Certificate of Substantial Completion on the Rendezvous Meadows Irrigation Project. The motion carried.

Al Radke, representing the Upper Green River Joint Powers Water Board, reported that the Geo Technical study for a dam on the Green River would cost approximately \$350,000.

In accordance with the public notice published in the Pinedale Roundup on October 29, 2010, public hearing was held for the following:

1. It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to approve a request by Brent and Kathy Vodopich and Kenneth and Joseph Ann Seaburg for a partial vacation and amendment of an existing plat for a boundary line adjustment, changing the existing lot lines between Lots 23, 26 and the two parts of Lot 29, Tyler Subdivision. The motion carried.

County Planner Bart Myers reported that the Letter of Credit for the electricity installation in Sand Draw III Subdivision has expired and the installation has not been completed. The Board referred the matter to the County Attorney.

Christine Priest, representing Groathouse Construction, reported on the addition of an ice pit with a spray bar for the Ice Arena. It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Bousman to approve the request in the amount of \$1,953.60. The motion carried.

Larry Berlin, representing Berlin Architect, reviewed Change Orders for the Old Pinedale Clinic project. It was moved by Commissioner Bousman and seconded by Commissioner Linn to approve Change Order #10, in the amount of \$263.34 for rain gutter over the ADA ramp, and Change Order #11, in the amount of \$2,890.25, for CK Construction for additional days and general conditions, due to a carpet delay and drywall issues. The motion carried. Berlin discussed Phase II and the drywall issues, similar to Phase I. It was decided, as in Phase I, to replace the drywall and wiring.

County Attorney Neal Stelting introduced Deputy County Attorney Matt Gaffney, who will be handling civil duties for the County.

Rex Poulson, representing the Citizens to Save White Pine, reported that White Pine will be opening on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Board approved plowing, once the agreements are signed.
