

**OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
JANUARY 24, 2011**

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session on this date at 1 p.m., in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse in Pinedale, Wyoming, with Joel Bousman, John Linn, Andy Nelson, Jerimiah Rieman from the Governor's Planning Office, by conference call, Jacque Buchanan, Bridger Teton Forest Supervisor, Kaitlyn McAvoy of the Pinedale Roundup, Dawn Ballou of Pinedale Online, Mari Muzzi of the Sublette Examiner, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

The purpose of the special session was for Jacque Buchanan, Bridger Teton Forest Supervisor, to update the Board on the past week's three public meetings for the draft environmental impact statement process for the Plains Exploration and Production leases in the Hoback Basin.

It was noted that public notice had been made on January 24, 2011.

Buchanan reported that the Final EIS for the Wyoming Range leases (44/7) would be available this week. Chairman Bousman is the County lead on this project.

The Board discussed the process for the PXP EIS and the County's participation. Buchanan reported that the EIS should be available in July or August. Public comments are due on March 11, 2011. Commissioner Linn is the lead on this project.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
