

**OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS**  
**JUNE 7, 2011**

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Sublette County Courthouse in Pinedale, Wyoming, on this date at 9:00 a.m. with Joel Bousman, Andy Nelson, John Linn, Matt Naber of the Sublette Examiner, Megan Rawlins of the Pinedale Roundup, and Mary Lankford, County Clerk present.

Chairman Bousman led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the preceding regular meeting of May 24, 2011, were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Nelson. The motion carried.

The official bond for Anita Bohm, Treasurer for the Town of Marbleton, in the amount of \$50,000 was approved and ordered filed with the County Treasurer.

Butch Penton, Road & Bridge Superintendent, reported on the crusher, the Fremont Lake Dam flood mitigation project by the Town of Pinedale, and the turning distance of 35 feet in Shelter Park. The cost of construction of Mathis Lane was discussed and the lack of a BLM easement for the road.

Mark Eater, representing Rio Verde Engineering, reported on the multi-plate repair, the Big Sandy Elkhorn project, and the Fairgrounds drainage project.

Commissioner Linn requested that Rio Verde inspect the Middle Piney Road for deterioration.

Reconstruction of the Big Piney Calpet Road was discussed.

The Fremont Lake Road easement enlargement for snow catchers was discussed.

Increasing the width of County Road easements from 60 to 100 feet was discussed.

It was moved by Commissioner Nelson and seconded by Commissioner Linn to adopt Resolution No. 11-100173B establishing the Sommers Realignment of the Sommers Board Access County Road No. 23-146A. The motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Nelson to approve Change Order #1 for the Buck Road Project to add 15 additional days, with no cost, to the project. The motion carried.

Brad Clingman, Waste Management Superintendent, reported on recycling, free dump days, and the purchase of an excavator. The Board commented that it had not received notice, as of this date, from Teton County regarding the continuation of the Landfill Contract, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Isabel Rucker reported on the May 23<sup>rd</sup> community meeting to discuss ozone. The Board discussed its activities on air quality.

The Board approved and Commissioner Nelson signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the BLM for the LaBarge Platform Project.

It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Nelson to issue a malt beverage permit to Big Country Outfitters on June 19, 2011 at Timberline Lodge and to the Pinedale Lions Club for the Rendezvous Pageant on July 10, 2011, at the Rendezvous Grounds. The motion carried.

The Board discussed a scholarship request from a parent of a Pinedale student. No action was taken.

Old Business: Commissioner Linn discussed WLCI, PXP, Mathis Lane, NPL, and transportation issues.

Commissioner Nelson reported on CLG and requested a meeting at the Fairgrounds.

Chairman Bousman reported on 44/7, PXP, the WCCA Building Committee Meeting, and the FNRPA attorney.

County Planner Bart Myers and Deputy County Attorney Matt Gaffney discussed the recent Comprehensive Plan Public Meeting, and the Gravel Mining Public Meeting.

Judge Curt Hawes, Clerk of Circuit Court Wendy Sutherland, and Treatment Court Coordinator Kathy Anderson updated the Board on Circuit Court activities and new laws becoming effective on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Christine Priest, representing Groathouse Construction, and Brian Gray, representing WLC, reviewed the bids for the infrastructure project at the Fire Tower site. The apparent low bidder was Eiden Construction. The Board discussed a recent incident at the Marbleton Recycling Center which required law enforcement, and the lack of respect for County employees by Eiden Construction employees. Galen Eiden, representing Eiden Construction, discussed the incident and agreed to be the contact person for this project, if the Board awarded it to Eiden Construction. It was moved by Commissioner Linn and seconded by Commissioner Nelson to award the bid to Eiden Construction for the amount of \$435,865.00. The motion carried.

The Board met with Jay Brower, Fairgrounds Caretaker, and appointed him the Fairgrounds Manager. Additional staff and the drainage project were discussed.
