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Fire Warden Annual Report

January 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016

I. EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

- Between January 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016, there were a total of 155 emergency responses:
 - Pinedale – 56
 - Big Piney/Marbleton – 25
 - Bondurant – 26
 - Boulder – 23
 - Daniel – 19
 - Kendall Valley – 6
- Our average turn out time in 2016 was 10 minutes and 16 seconds.

II. FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

- There were (16) sixteen fire investigations between January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016.

III. FIRE PREVENTION

- **SMOKE DETECTOR PROGRAM**
 - 15 smoke detectors were installed throughout Sublette County in 2016.
- **SLASH PILES BURNED** – Seven (7)
- **COMMUNITY EDUCATION EVENTS** – Sixteen (16)

IV. TRAINING

- **FIRE TRAINING**
 - 49 State Issued Training Qualifications were issued in 2016. This is more than any other agency in the state of Wyoming.
 - 2,268 classes were attended, with a total of 9,027 training hours.

V. HEALTH & SAFETY

- A MOU was signed with Dr. Albritton-McDonald to oversee the health and fitness program.
- Tracking system was implemented for medical, wildland, annual training requirements.
- Blood borne pathogen exposure plan is in effect.
- SCBA fit testing has been completed.

VI. HOURS SPENT IN 2016

- The firefighters donated 2,334 volunteer hours throughout the County and community.
- Firefighters spent 13,640:12 hours with Alarm responses.
- Training hours for firefighters totaled 10,385:10 hours.

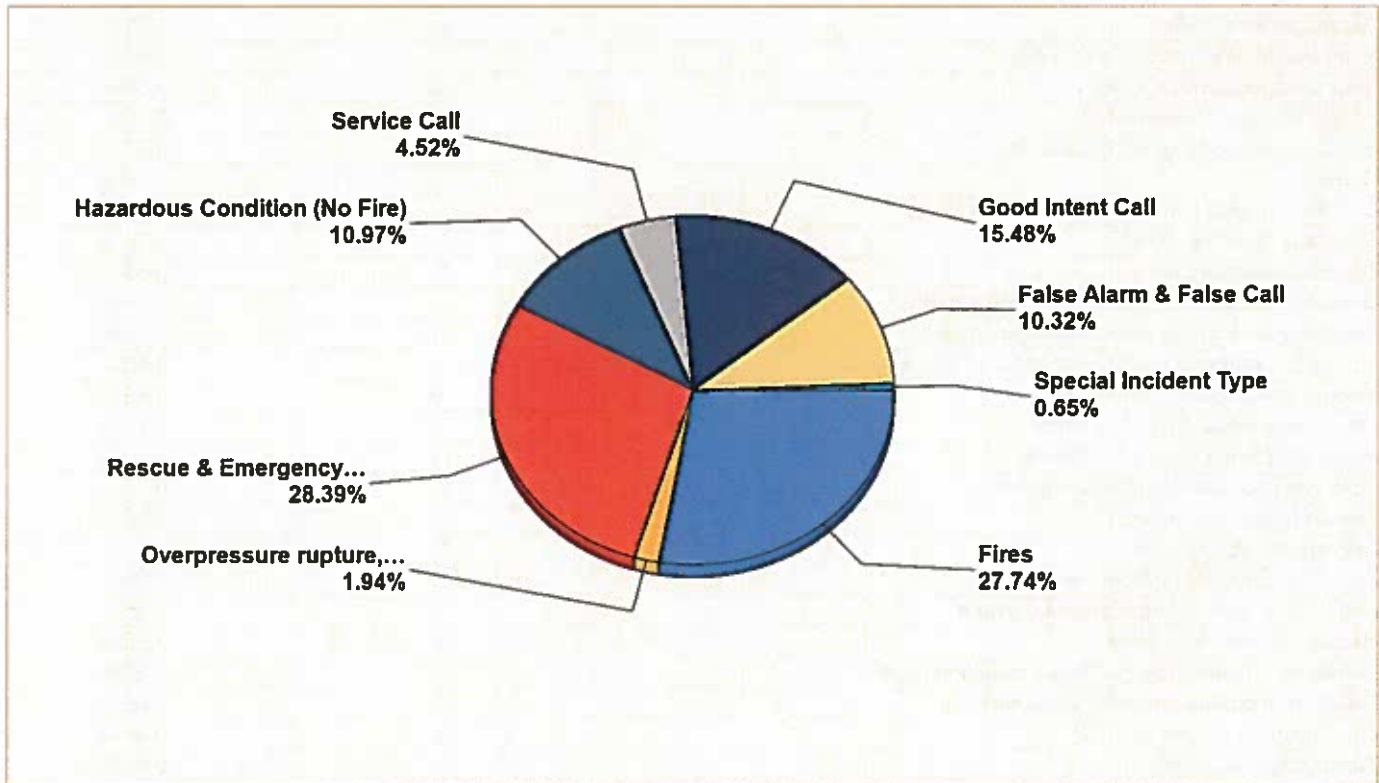

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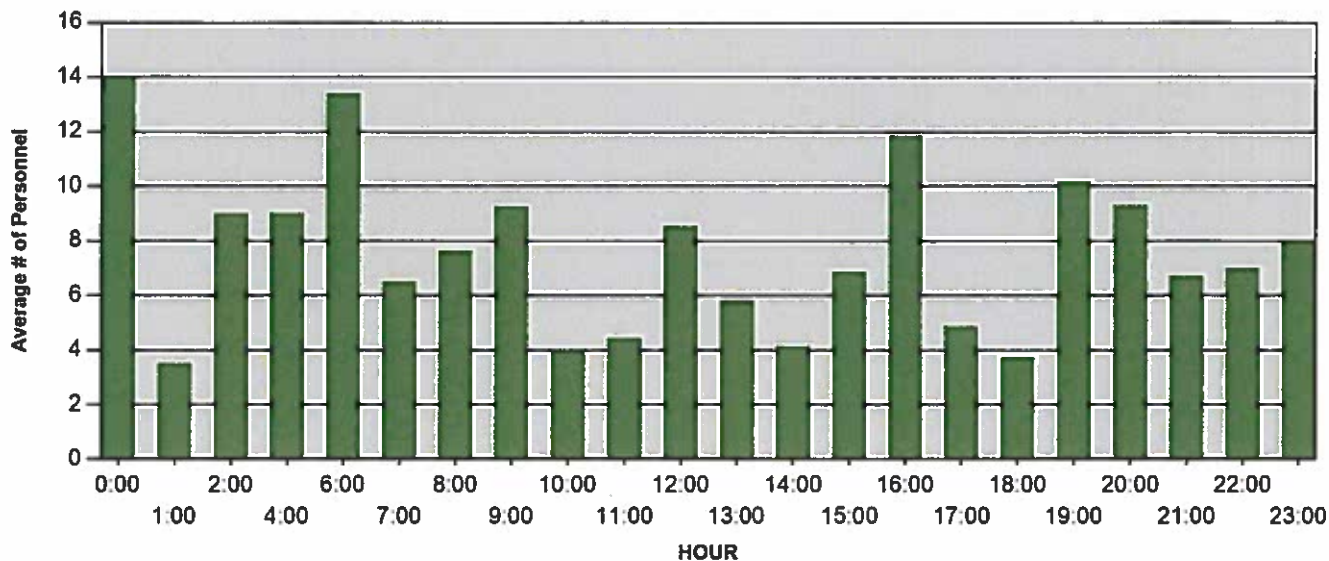
