

OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

MAY 4, 2021

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Lovatt Room of the Sublette County Library on this date with Joel Bousman, Tom Noble, Doug Vickrey, Sam White, Dave Stephens, Clayton Melinkovich, Matt Gaffney, Brady Oltmans representing the Pinedale Roundup, and Carrie Long, County Clerk, present.

Chairman Bousman led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Agenda was approved on motion by Commissioner White, seconded by Commissioner Noble with the addition of a F.N.R.P.A. funding discussion added after Chief Cooper's discussion. Motion carried.

The minutes of the preceding meeting on April 20 were approved and ordered filed on motion by Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner Stephens.

Billy Pape, Road & Bridge, updated the Board on activities.

Mike Jackson, Rio Verde Engineering, informed the Board the Town of Pinedale Council had approved the right of way swap with the county regarding S. Tyler and Fremont Lake Road maintenance. It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner White to proceed with the process of making the trade. Motion carried.

Shad Cooper, Fire Warden, presented a "Draft – SCUF Strategic Plan" to the Board for their consideration and review. He stated he would be submitting the plan to the towns and community for feedback before requesting final approval from the Board.

Cooper advised the Board he had been contacted by the Governor's Office regarding an award of up to \$80,000 with a 20 percent match from Sublette County toward the total cost of \$100,000 to assist Sublette County in updating the County's Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP). It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to accept the F.N.R.P.A. grant. Motion carried 4 to 1 with Commissioner Vickrey voting nay.

It was moved by Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner White to allow Mainstreet Pinedale use of the courthouse lawn for Pinedale Cleanup Day on May 22nd with consultation and guidance from Andre, Maintenance Supervisor. Motion carried.

Dennis Fornstrom, representing River Ranch, advised the Board the county and River Ranch have a common boundary line between his property and the property where the Extension Office is located and the fence is in disrepair. It was moved by Commissioner Stephens, seconded by Commissioner White to approve \$4900 for the county's portion of repairing the fence.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to approve accounts payable in the amount of \$662,327.99. Motion carried.

Chairman Bousman requested approval of an invoice from Richard Stem, in the amount of \$1,140.00 for consulting work done on behalf of Sublette County with the Coalition of Local Government. It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to approve payment. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Vickrey, seconded by Commissioner White to approve payroll in the amount of \$967,081.36. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner White, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to approve bonds for Tessa Manning as Treasurer of the Fayette Irrigation District and as Treasurer of the Highland Irrigation District. Motion carried.

There were no Notice of Valuation Changes from the Assessor's office.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to approve a request for Change of Zoning District Boundary by The Bradley Trust dated 2 November 1995 for 5-acres of the 100.8 acre of (A-1) Agricultural Zoned property to be Re-Zoned to (I-L) Light Industrial Zoning District. Motion carried with Commissioner Vickrey recusing himself from voting.

It was moved by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens to approve a request from Jason & Melinda Moyes for a Variance pursuant to Chapter VI of the Sublette County Zoning and Development regulations. The proposed variance is to the setback requirement of Chapter III, Section 4, Setback requirements for Gas Pumps and Storage Tanks. Motion carried.

A request for a Boundary Line Adjustment and Replat of Lots 8 & 9 of the BB Village by Mark Perry and Tarek Ellsworth was approved on motion by Commissioner Noble, seconded by Commissioner Stephens. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner White, seconded by Commissioner Vickrey to approve the Revision of the Sublette County Road Standards as presented by Dennis Fornstrom and Mike Jackson. Motion carried.
