

## OFFICIAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

**JUNE 4, 2021**

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session in the Lovatt Room of the Sublette County Library in Pinedale, Wyoming, on this date at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of preparation of the FY22 budget with Joel Bousman, Tom Noble, Doug Vickrey, Sam White, Dave Stephens, Matt Gaffney, Carrie Long and Jeness Saxton present. Mark Eatinger presented the Museum Board budget request. The commissioners questioned the removal of security system for the Green River Valley Museum. They asked for more information so they could consider adding that amount back to the budget. Clint Gilchrist presented the budget and discussed projects for the Historic Preservation Board (CLG). Sukey Hohl then presented for the Library Board. The Recreation Board budget was presented by Betty Cheeney and Terry Cain. Discussion was had about the pros and cons of their line item regarding the Big Piney baseball fields. Bill Kluck presented a request for \$25,000 to be funded from the sale of the "Big Red." The request is being made in order to purchase a new lift for an existing ambulance. Cat Urbigkit presented the Predator Board budget. Commissioner Bousman stated that he feels livestock producers are being subsidized by the county because the portion of the brand inspection fee that is allocated to the predator board is too low. Carrie then presented the budgets of the local preschools (Discovery Center, Pinedale Preschool and The Learning Center). Discussion was had again this year about an appropriate method to equalize their funding. The metric used for such equalization was the subject of some discussion, with no resolution. Some commissioners felt that coordination with the schools would be required to resolve the issue. Carrie presented the budgets of the Visitor Center, Sublette Center, Rendezvous Point (also discussion about how to equalize funding of the senior centers), Van Vleck House, Harris Buildout carryover, SAFV / TANF grant, Veteran Services and the Centennial Committee carryover.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned with no action taken.
